Objective #1: Maintain Institutional Accreditation with COE and ABHES

Verve College is a reputable and a legitimate nursing college in the state of Illinois and its management understands the importance of accreditation. Verve College understands that accreditation means that our institution provides a quality education, while giving students an opportunity to be successful and advance in their career. Therefore, Verve College's main priority is to remain in compliance with the COE commission by annually submitting the annual report, paying annual dues, and attending workshops as needed for reaffirmation of accreditation. Also, Verve College wants to maintain a first time NCLEX-PN pass rate above 91%, a completion rate above 76%, and a placement rate above 76% as well. In order to achieve this, Verve College faculty and management has to regularly review the curriculum along with the resources being provided to the students. Moreover, this means that some faculty members may have to attend some webinars or participate in training in order to achieve such a high NCLEX-PN pass rate. In general, Verve College closely monitors its NCLEX-PN pass rates and results are retrieved quarterly from IDFPR. Also, the progress is evaluated on a quarterly basis. Additionally, on a monthly basis, Verve College management will analyze reports regarding the completion and placement rate as well.

Strategies for Achieving and Evaluating this Objective

Undoubtedly, to maintain institutional accreditation Verve College administration, faculty, and management will all have to maintain a consistent work ethic. Consequently, meetings will occur regularly and certain faculty along with staff members will be held accountable for completing certain tasks. Also, Verve College's management team will review reports highlighting retention, placement, and completion on a consistent basis throughout the year.

Furthermore, progress toward achieving this objective will be measured by Verve College's success in meeting deadlines established by the accreditor and meeting the benchmarks required for successful annual report completion.
