- Maintain professionalism across the span of the entire program.
- Must not have any breach of the student code of conduct.
- No disciplinary actions for either academic reason and/or any misconduct.
- Must pay a one-time fee to join the honor society.

Student Advising and Counseling

Academic advising is provided to students throughout the program. Faculty provides 1:1 advising, which included module monitoring and student assessment regularly scheduled throughout the semester. In addition, the faculty provides, as needed, 1:1 academic advising with the students. During the 1:1 advising session, the faculty member discusses with each student individually their current state of academics, what difficulties the students are facing, and what steps to take to overcome the difficulties to succeed in the program. During these meetings instructors identify areas of opportunities for students by examining their overall academic performance, use of resources, and attendance. Individual recommendations are made for improvement.
